Texas Frontier Trails: Heritage Park

TFT offers several hiking trails into the hills with some great historic interpretive panels along the path. Just beyond the hiking trails stands a beautiful rock bridge that spans over Pollard Creek. It's the perfect spot to take in the peaceful sounds of nature. Trickling creek, rustling leaves of the trees, songbirds serenading and of course, the mating call of the cicadas.

Lake Mineral Wells State Park

LMWSP is an adventure lover's dream. They offer everything from hiking and biking to camping, canoeing and rock-climbing.

Lake Mineral Wells Trailway

LMW Trailway runs along the old historic Weatherford, Mineral Wells & Northwestern Railroad offering 20 miles of hike, bike, and equestrian trails exploring the sites of the Western Cross Timbers from Mineral Wells to Weatherford.

The Hatchet House

If you haven't tried your hand at axe throwing, we have just the place for you. And if you get hungry while you're there, head out to The Yard (The Hatchet House's patio) for some great food trucks and live music.

West City Park

This is the largest city park in Mineral Wells where, you'll find playscapes, swimming pool, and ball fields. But tucked away on the west side of the park is a humble little trailhead leading to hilltop hiking trails. It's a bit of a climb, but once you're there, you'll be treated to some incredible views of Mineral Wells.
